

## **Stumptown Disc Golf Meeting October 11, 2007**

**Meeting called to order** at 6:15 p.m. There were 10 members and 1 guest present.

**Minutes approved** – Wes Hansen read the minutes and they were approved by those in attendance.

### **Reports & Old Business**

- Next Adventure - Bryan Knudsen announced that starting today 15% discount on anything in the store to SDG members. This discount is not retroactive to past purchases. He shared that he is very excited to help SDG as we grow.
- Web Site - Updates to the web site are in progress. Spam Bots have been locked out
- Pier Work Party - 15 members planted 5 new anchors and spread bark dust at numerous holes in the rain. Baskets are in the new pin placements currently.
- Next Work Party Saturday Nov 3 at Dabney – Motioned, Seconded and passed. We need a good crew to help out to prepare for the Winter Series event.
- Venturing Crew Insurance – It was reported that the plan to secure insurance through the Venturing Crew program will not work.
- Membership Report – As of October 11<sup>th</sup> we now have over 100 members.
- It was reported that at the Hab Rec event there was good publicity for SDG
- In the absence of the treasurer it was reported that we have approximately \$1180 in our account.

### **New Business**

- Upcoming Meeting Dates – It was proposed that the next meeting be held Tuesday, November 13<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m. at Next Adventure. The motion was seconded and passed
- Pier Park Materials Reimbursement – A motion to reimburse Dave Blado for expenses for materials for Pier Park, reimburse expenses up to \$200 was made but died after discussion. A new motion for to reimburse up to \$300 was seconded, passed after discussion.
- Membership Signups – A proposal that any new member registrations starting Nov 1 carries on to 2008 year was seconded and passed.
- Bag Tag 2008 – A motion to keep bag tags same as this year was seconded and passed after discussion.
- PDGA Affiliation – A motion to sign up for PDGA affiliation for the club for six months was seconded and passed after discussion. PDGA affiliation is free for first 6 months and \$25 per year for the club after that. Members save \$5 on PDGA membership when the memberships are collected by the club and sent in together. Also free officials testing, a spot on the PDGA web site, and discounts on merchandise on the PDGA web site are other benefits.
- Winter Series – There was much discussion over specifics of the upcoming series. The tournament directors will take the suggestions into account as they plan for the events.
- SDG Patches – A proposal for Jason Pinkel to order SDG patches with logo in various colors was seconded and passed.
